Online learning offers students a contemporary means through which the University continues its tradition of outreach and open learning opportunities. Online degree-credit courses are offered by the School of Continuing Studies (SCS) in collaboration with academic departments and schools. This option provides students the opportunity to create a flexible study schedule, acquire credits while away on summer break or a co-op placement, and/or choose to learn in an interactive online course environment.

Online courses are designed to foster interactivity between students, their instructors and the content. Students can expect to engage in activities, such as online discussions and individual and group assignments, using a variety of technologies and resources.
